**Silent Confession** 

### **Assurance of Pardon**

Romans 5:8

But God shows His love for us in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

- † Confession of Faith Westminster Confession of Faith ch. 15, sec. 1-5
  - 1. Repentance unto life is an evangelical grace, the doctrine whereof is to be preached by every minister of the gospel, as well as that of faith in Christ.
  - 2. By it, a sinner, out of the sight and sense not only of the danger, but also of the filthiness and odiousness of his sins, as contrary to the holy nature, and righteous law of God; and upon the apprehension of His mercy in Christ to such as are penitent, so grieves for, and hates his sins, as to turn from them all unto God, purposing and endeavoring to walk with Him in all the ways of His commandments.
  - 3. Although repentance be not to be rested in, as any satisfaction for sin, or any cause of the pardon thereof, which is the act of God's free grace in Christ; yet it is of such necessity to all sinners, that none may expect pardon without it.
  - 4. As there is no sin so small, but it deserves damnation; so there is no sin so great, that it can bring damnation upon those who truly repent.
  - 5. Men ought not to content themselves with a general repentance, but it is every man's duty to endeavor to repent of his particular sins, particularly.

### **Scripture Reading**

Ezekiel 44:1-16; 28

¹Then He brought me back to the outer gate of the sanctuary, which faces east. And it was shut. ² And the LORD said to me, "This gate shall remain shut; it shall not be opened, and no one shall enter by it, for the LORD, the God of Israel, has entered by it. Therefore it shall remain shut. ³ Only the prince may sit in it to eat bread before the LORD. He shall enter by way of the vestibule of the gate, and shall go out by the same way."

<sup>4</sup>Then He brought me by way of the north gate to the front of the temple, and I looked, and behold, the glory of the LORD filled the temple of the LORD. And I fell on my face. <sup>5</sup>And the LORD said to me, "Son of man, mark well, see with your eyes, and hear with your ears all that I shall tell you concerning all the statutes of the temple of the LORD and all its laws. And mark well the entrance to the temple and all the exits from the sanctuary. <sup>6</sup>And say to the rebellious house, to the house of Israel, Thus says the Lord GoD: O house of Israel, enough of all your abominations, <sup>7</sup>in admitting foreigners, uncircumcised in heart and flesh, to be in My sanctuary, profaning My temple, when you offer to Me My food, the fat and the blood. You have broken My covenant, in addition to all your abominations. <sup>8</sup>And you have not kept charge of My holy things,

but you have set others to keep My charge for you in My sanctuary.

<sup>9</sup> "Thus says the Lord GoD: No foreigner, uncircumcised in heart and flesh, of all the foreigners who are among the people of Israel, shall enter My sanctuary. <sup>10</sup> But the Levites who went far from Me, going astray from Me after their idols when Israel went astray, shall bear their punishment. <sup>11</sup> They shall be ministers in My sanctuary,

having oversight at the gates of the temple and ministering in the temple. They shall slaughter the burnt offering and the sacrifice for the people, and they shall stand before the people, to minister to them. <sup>12</sup> Because they ministered to them before their idols and became a stumbling block of iniquity to the house of Israel, therefore I have sworn concerning them, declares the Lord God, and they shall bear their punishment.

<sup>13</sup> They shall not come near to Me, to serve Me as priest, nor come near any of My holy things and the things that are most holy, but they shall bear their shame and the abominations that they have committed. <sup>14</sup> Yet I will appoint them to keep charge of the temple, to do all its service and all that is to be done in it.

<sup>15</sup> "But the Levitical priests, the sons of Zadok, who kept the charge of My sanctuary when the people of Israel went astray from Me,

shall come near to Me to minister to Me. And they shall stand before Me to offer Me the fat and the blood, declares the Lord God. <sup>16</sup> They shall enter My sanctuary, and they shall approach My table, to minister to Me, and they shall keep My charge.

"This shall be their inheritance: I am their inheritance: and you shall give them no possession in Israel; I am their possession.
